



Native plant list

There are many varieties of trees, shrubs and vines that have "evolved" here in the Northwest and are best suited to thrive in our unique environment without a lot of maintenance. Being well adapted, these native plants weather our Northwest cycles of soggy, wet winters and springs followed by summer droughts very well, making them less susceptible to insect damage and disease.

We encourage you to use these native plants in your landscaping to conserve water and enhance our environment.
