Customer Checklist for Utility Interconnection

- Submit an application to the Utility
 - ✓ Interconnection inverter must be UL 1541 Listed
 - ✓ Electrical schematic drawing must be included
 - ✓ Include provisions for a lockable visible disconnect
- Send application to Clark Public Utilities, P.O. Box 8900, Vancouver, WA 98668, ATTN: Sam Walker
- Receive written design approval from the Utility
- Get an electrical permit from Washington State L & I (360-896-2300). Follow the National Electric Code (NEC) as required
- Complete the installation
- Get inspections from a state electrical inspector and the Utility
- If net metered, Utility approves, or installs new, bi-directional meter
- If production metered, applicant purchases and installs, and Utility approves, production meter
- Submit Certificate of Completion to Utility
- Start generating power
