

Need Help Paying Your Heating Bill?



Payment assistance may be available to help you pay your energy bill – electric, gas, oil, wood or propane.

Call the toll-free phone number below to see if you qualify and make an appointment for the federally funded Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). All appointments are scheduled on a first come first serve basis. Callers are encouraged to call daily to try to schedule the appointment.

This automated line, open seven days a week, will also verify appointments and will provide general information including current household income limits. The LIHEAP program for Clark County is administered by Clark Public Utilities and funds are available to assist with all heating types.

To use the energy assistance appointment line, have a paper and pen ready when you call (1-855-353-HEAT). You will be asked to enter your heat type, total household income, and may be asked to enter your utility account number.
