ABOUT OUR WATER SYSTEM

Clark Public Utilities is a customer-owned public utility district providing water to more than 30,000 homes and businesses in Clark County.

The system includes 33 storage tanks, 50 booster stations, 30 wells, and 800 miles of water main, and is the tenth largest public water system in the State of Washington with a service area of approximately 200 square miles.

Communities served include Hazel Dell, Salmon Creek, Lakeshore, Felida, Mt. Vista, LaCenter, Brush Prairie, Hockinson, Venersborg, Heisson, Meadow Glade, Dollars Corner, Duluth, Pioneer, Manor, Amboy, and Yacolt.

We work every day to ensure the safest, cleanest, and highest quality water possible.

ONGOING EFFORTS INCLUDE:

- Live electronic monitoring of the water system, 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Regular, in person, site visits to all system facilities to ensure proper working order
- Annual well and distribution system water quality sampling and analysis
- Monthly collection and testing of approximately 100 coliform bacteria samples throughout the main distribution and satellite systems
- Regular testing of treatment systems pre- and post-filtration for iron and manganese removal to ensure optimal performance
- Sampling and testing for lead and copper every three years
- Regular testing for a variety of other chemicals and compounds
