



Journeyman Lineman

This is a regular, full-time position located at the Ed Fischer Operations Center.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

Perform construction and maintenance activities on transmission and distribution power lines between substations and consumers. Depending upon qualifications, may be temporarily assigned work other than his/her classification.

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following:

- Opens switches or clamps grounding device to energized equipment to de-energize lines or accessories.
- Climbs poles or rides in bucket attached to truck-mounted boom to remove broken or defective wires.
- Secures new wires to cross arm insulators and splices wire to adjoining sections of line to complete circuit. Transfers wires from defective poles to poles. Installs pole hardware and such auxiliary equipment as transformers, lightning arresters, switches, fuses, and insulators, using hand tools.
- Suspends insulated ladders and platforms from pole cross arms and covers energized lines with rubber mats to facilitate safe handling of high-voltage lines with interrupting service by power shutoff and uses long insulated poles (hot-sticks) fitted with mechanically or hydraulically operated grasping and crimping tools.

QUALIFICATIONS:

High school graduate. Satisfactory completion of an approved apprenticeship program or has otherwise satisfied the district that he/she is a fully qualified electrical worker. Must have and maintain a commercial driver's license. Must meet utility medical standards for this occupation.
