

METERBASES

- ▶ After installation of a meterbase, inspect to ensure no loose material is present, including metal shavings, meter rings, unattached hardware, idle 5th jaw, etc. Factory meter rings should be disposed of as Clark Public Utilities will install new meter rings. Any loose material can be a hidden hazard during energization, if a line crew were to miss them during their hazard assessment.
- ▶ Temporary power routed into the load side of service panels can be very dangerous. When utility crews arrive to energize the permanent service and there is an alternate source routed into the panel, with the main closed, it could back feed 7200V onto the distribution system. Once a service has been approved to energize by the authority having jurisdiction (WA LNI or COV Electrical) a temporary service cannot be re-routed into the panel unless it has been re-permitted and re-inspected as a temporary service. This is out of WAC compliance and is citable by the authority having jurisdiction.

GENERAL REMINDER

- ▶ **Standbys**
 - Prepare your site for work to begin once the inspector arrives
 - Do not undermine equipment
 - Have the proper amount of able and ready personnel to complete the task
 - If the inspector feels the project is not ready or unsafe they will relock the equipment and leave
 - Have lube ready for wire pulls
 - Standbys should be scheduled 48 hours in advance (360-992-8839)
- ▶ **Overtightening is causing damage**
 - Do not use impact guns to tighten bolts and connectors
 - Bolts are being stripped and/or broken
 - Street light wire and ground wires are being stripped and/or broken
- ▶ **False or misleading advertising will lead to delisting**
 - Only the work completed by the installer should be advertised or quoted
 - Do not advertise that the energizing will be completed by your company

BE PREPARED BEFORE YOU CALL

- ▶ **Have your job number and information available for reference when contacting Clark Public Utilities personnel**
 - Work needs to be ready prior to scheduling standbys

- ▶ **Read the step-by-step instruction detailed on the construction print**

SPLICE PITS

- ▶ Splice pits are the liability and responsibility of the contractor to secure and maintain safely from time of excavation until its closure
- ▶ Caution tape, cones, barricades, plywood and steel covers should be used to safely secure an open pit
- ▶ Please schedule and work your project to minimize the duration of open pits and trenches
- ▶ Once Clark Public Utilities has completed their work in the pit, they will notify the contractor/customer to backfill
