LIGHT LINES

USE SPACE HEATERS SAFELY

Space heaters can be great for chasing away chills on a cold winter day, but never trade comfort for safety when using them. The soothing warmth space heaters provide can also be dangerous when not operated properly.

Practice the 3-foot rule and keep your space heater at least 3 feet away from any flammable objects such as paper, drapes, dusty surfaces or bedding.

Space heaters should only be used on the floor never on a shelf, stool or bed. Never place them on a carpet or rug – hard and flat surfaces are ideal.

Never use a space heater with an extension cord and remember to shut it off before leaving the room or going to bed to prevent it from overheating, blowing a fuse or even causing a fire if left unattended.

REPORT POWER OUTAGES AND RECEIVE UPDATES



Recent heavy rains and strong winds are a good reminder to prepare now for winter power outages. Although Clark Public Utilities works year round to prevent weather-related outages before they happen, the power can still go out.

Customers can help crews get the lights back on quickly by reporting outages right away. To report an outage, call PowerLine at 360-992-8000 or use the report an outage tool at ClarkPublicUtilities.com.

Either tool will also provide updates on current outages in the system and the online outage map can show outage locations countywide.

Utility power lines are often several miles long, outage reports can help pinpoint the exact location and cause of the outage. When crews respond to outages in the middle of the night or in bad weather this information can help make restoration much faster.

If your phone number has changed, let us know! PowerLine connects customer phone numbers with the account's address to help determine the location of the outage. If your number no longer matches your address, it will not produce an accurate report. To update, add the new number on your payment stub, email it, fill out our online form, visit MyAccount or call us at 360-992-3000.

To receive outage alerts via text, call or email, sign up for notifications in MyAccount anytime.
