

Engineering Manager – Water

This full-time position reports to the Director of Water and is located at the Ed Fischer Operations Center, 8600 NE 117th Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98662.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

This position is responsible for the planning, coordination and development of capital projects including water mains, reservoirs, booster pump stations and well houses. This person will manage civil engineers, CAD/GIS staff and collaborate with fellow managers and staff, to achieve goals within budgeted funds and available personnel. Develops Capital Improvement Plan in conjunction with Operations and Water Quality and Production Managers.

- Supervision of engineers managing multiple projects related to the production, distribution and storage of potable water.
- Develop, monitor and maintain budget including process, O&M and Capital
- Coordinate water main replacements with county and state road construction projects
- Coordinate Local Utility District (LUD) for potable water to customers.
- Initiate acquisition of properties for future facilities
- Coordinate updates to the Water System Plan
- Maintain and update system maps, standards, and specifications
- Manage construction and planning activities on a weekly basis

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering or related field required.
- Professional Engineer in the State of Washington with a minimum of four years' experience preferred.
- Additional studies in hydraulics, modeling software and construction management preferred.
- Experience in design of transmission mains and subdivisions, and construction management preferred.
- Technical knowledge of potable water transmission and distribution systems, storage, pumping, and control systems.
- Excellent organizational skills including ability to work effectively in self-directed environment.
- Demonstrated proficiency in MS Office Suite.
- Strong written and oral communication skills with ability to articulate complicated subject matter.
