Flagger/Line Helper

This full-time position reports to a Construction/Maintenance Supervisor and is located at the Operations Center, 8600 NE 117th Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98662. The work schedule is Monday through Friday, 7:00am to 3:30pm.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

Controls movement of vehicular traffic through construction projects. Discusses traffic routing plans, and type and location of control points with supervisor. Distributes traffic control signs and markers along site in designated pattern. Directs movement of traffic through site using sign, hand, and flag signals to prevent accident and injury to workers. Warns line crews when approaching vehicle fails to heed signals to prevent accident and injury to workers. Informs drivers of detour routes through construction sites. Records license number of traffic control violators for police.

May assist electrical workers in installation, maintenance, and repair of electric power distribution equipment, underground cables, and related facilities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must have completed a Flagger Certification course or successfully complete a Flagger Certification course within six months after selection. Valid Driver's License required. Commercial Driver's License preferred.

BENEFITS:

Employees and dependents are eligible for medical, dental, vision, basic life insurance and disability insurance. Employees are enrolled in Washington State PERS and may enroll in deferred compensation plans. Employees will also receive eight hours of vacation leave and sick leave every month and twelve paid holidays throughout the calendar year.
