FUNDAMENTALS OF ENERGY EFFICIENT BUILDING OPERATIONS

This introductory course teaches the basic principles of energy efficiency awareness and practices in commercial buildings. The content of this course is designed for those seeking a solid foundational understanding of energy efficiency and building systems who have less than a year of experience in the field, are looking to start a career in facilities or energy management, and those whose work intersects with facilities and the built environment. This content covers basic information well-suited to those who work in facility operations, as well as energy and resource conservation management, such as commercial strategic energy managers and resource conservation managers. Students will gain knowledge to implement immediate low-cost changes that benefit their facility operations.

The content is derived from core Building Operator Certification® (BOC) concepts.

After completing this course, participants will be able to:

- Achieve general awareness of facilities and instill efficiency ethic
- Reinforce BOC concepts
- Strengthen building optimization skills
- Identify areas for energy savings
- Make energy-smart decisions in day-to-day tasks
