

Student – ComCare

This position reports to the Work Group Leader - ComCare and is located at the Electric Center, 1200 Fort Vancouver Way, Vancouver, WA 98668. This is a part-time, temporary student position open through June 2026. The scheduled hours of work will be Monday through Friday 8am to 5pm however, work schedules will be determined with consideration around student class schedule commitments.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

This position offers an opportunity to learn first-hand the details of the various heat assistance programs. The ComCare team relies upon one another on a daily basis to collaborate on best solutions for households. Strong candidates are able to type 35 words per minute with some experience with Microsoft Office products.

Includes working with the Clark Public Utilities Community Care staff and applicants for low income heat assistance programs. Requires being able to work within a team setting and with the public. Strong candidates would include someone that is approachable, a self-starter and able to work independently. Some of the job duties would include but are not limited to the following tasks:

- Provide frontline support to the ComCare Receptionist to greet and check in customers for scheduled appointments with strong attention to the front desk and high volume of customer activity.
- Collect and organize confidential documents for applicants applying for energy assistance programs.
- Enter data into a grant database.
- Track forms received and work with directly with Clark Public Utilities Community Care representatives to determine outcomes and next steps for applicants.
- Prepare files for applicant appointments
- Communicating with potential applicants about program eligibility requirements.
- Assisting Community Care representatives with applicants during appointments.

QUALIFICATIONS:

High school graduate, and must be enrolled in college with a minimum of 10 credit hours. Experience using Microsoft Office products preferred. Must demonstrate the ability to type at least 35 words per minute with minimal errors.

BENEFITS:

As a public utility district in Washington State, Clark Public Utilities student employees may be enrolled in the Public Employee Retirement System. Student employees will also receive one hour of sick leave for every forty hours worked.

SALARY:

Salary ranges are market based and established annually. Student employees are eligible for pay increases based on the number of hours worked.
