

Residential Planner

This full-time position reports to the Manager of Construction Design and is located at the Ed Fischer Operations Center, 8600 NE 117th Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98662.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

- Advise customers on technical information pertaining to their request for new service and act as a technical liaison for the customer and contractor.
- Explain District guidelines, fee schedules and design parameters to customers.
- Perform necessary field visits to obtain needed design information.
- Work with Right-of-Way to acquire easements and resolve property issues.
- Prepare necessary permit applications for City, County and State permits.
- Utilize design, work management and estimating programs to develop design and job estimate. Determine phasing, calculate loading and fuse coordination to meet utility standards. Prepare cost estimate sheet and material issue.
- Prepare necessary documents for issue to Operations Office and work closely with T & D Superintendents and Construction Coordinators regarding construction practices to ensure smooth completion of jobs.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Minimum 2 years of electric utility or construction related experience and/or 2-year college degree preferred. Experience or training in residential or commercial construction practices preferred. Fundamental knowledge of utility engineering design, construction practices and basic electrical principles. Knowledge and ability to interpret technical drawings, schematics and electric system maps. Knowledgeable in the use of trigonometry and algebraic calculations. Familiarity with personal property rights, right-of-way and easements. Proficient in working with the Utility's information systems including Customer Information, Work Management, and GIS as well as AutoCAD and the MS Office suite. Must have outstanding interpersonal skills and must be customer service focused, creative, flexible, and team-oriented. Significant interaction with customers is required. Ability to spend a significant portion of the work day visiting outdoor construction sites in all weather conditions.

BENEFITS:
