CAREFUL WITH CORDS AND DECORATIONS



Be careful where and how you use extension cords around the holidays. In addition to being a tripping hazard, damaged cords can cause a shock or a fire. Make sure cords aren't damaged and are the right size for the job. Don't run them behind furniture. under rugs, through doorways or secure them with staples or nails.

When connecting cords outside, make sure they are marked for outdoor use and in an appropriate outlet.
