Facilities Technician – Mechanical

This full-time position reports to the Facilities Manager and is located at the Ed Fischer Operations Center, 8600 NE 117th Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98662. The work schedule is Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

Perform all functions necessary for the efficient construction, installation, operation, maintenance, and repair of all mechanical and electrical equipment for climate control and creature comfort, facilities heating and air conditioning, building automation controls, plumbing, fire systems, refrigeration, lighting, power, and other utilities on district properties or commercial and industrial facilities as directed, plus occasional minor repairs to customer's premises and property.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must have knowledge of various national and State of Washington codes, laws and regulations as applicable. Must have and maintain a current first aid card. Must have the ability to read, legibly write and converse in the English language. Must have current driver's license. Must be able to satisfactorily communicate with people, both fellow employees and the general public. Must have a good knowledge of utility policies and procedures. Must be able to read and interpret blueprints, electrical schematic drawings, sketches, instructions and directions.

Possession of HVAC/refrigeration 06A License and Universal Refrigeration Certificate or the ability to acquire each within six (6) months is required. Must have ability to work independently, with little direct supervision. Must have commercial journeyman level experience and a satisfactory level of competence in the following specialized fields: commercial heating, ventilation, refrigeration and air conditioning; electrical and pneumatic controls; hydronics, mechanical and electrical plant systems; major appliances and industrial controls; air, water and electrical distribution. Must have mechanical aptitude and ability to learn and develop at acceptable rate. Must be able to learn and apply the knowledge and skills necessary to function as a Facilities Technician – Mechanical. Must have the expectation that there may be after-hours trouble-calls, emergencies and the ability to respond.

This position is designated as safety-sensitive due to the nature of the work and its potential impact on the safety of employees, the public, and organizational operations. In accordance with our drug-free workplace policy, compliance with applicable testing and safety requirements is a condition of employment.

BENEFITS:

Employees and dependents are eligible for medical, dental, vision, basic life insurance and disability insurance. Employees are enrolled in Washington State PERS and may enroll in deferred compensation plans. Employees will also receive eight hours of vacation leave and sick leave every month and twelve paid holidays throughout the calendar year.
